

Angled Easel Cupcake Project

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x 15 cm square card blank - white
- 2 x 15 cm square card - decorative - pink
- 1 x 9.5 x 12 cm foiled card - silver
- 1 x 7.5 x 2.5 cm foiled card - silver
- 1 x 9 x 11.5 card - pink
- 1 x 7 x 2 cm card - pink
- Greeting peel off - silver
- Cupcake decoupage sets - included

How to assemble this project:



Open up the main card & score a line from the top left to bottom right on the inside front. Fold in this line & crease well. Secure the decorative pink card directly onto the inside back of the main card without any borders showing.

Draw a diagonal line on the back of the second square of decorative pink card & cut. Put one piece aside for a future project & secure the second to the diagonal front of the main card as seen in the photo above.

Layer the pink card square onto the foiled card square using double sided adhesive foam pads, & then attach more pads to the lower portion on the back & attach to the diagonal front of the card with an approx.1.5 cm border at the bottom & left of the panel.

Cut out the two cupcake decoupage sets, & using more pads, layer up each. Attach the large cupcake centrally onto the pink card panel on the front of the card.

Layer up the smaller pink card to the remaining silver foil card using the adhesive pads; attach the smaller cupcake decoupage to the left hand side & the peel off greeting to the right. Open up the card & slide the easel to the desired position & affix the greeting panel in such a way that the small cupcake decoupage is the stopper preventing the card from sliding closed.
