

Cafe Latté Card Collection

(3) Corsage

What you will need to replicate this project:-

2 x A5 card blanks – brown

1 x A6 embossed Cordinations card – distressed

2 rectangles of 4.3 x 9.6 cm trimmed from 30 cm paper

1 x 9.5 cm square, cut in half diagonally, from 30 cm paper

Die cut & embossed Cordinations circle - brown

Scrap of Cordinations card – Cream

Die cut & embossed tag approx. 9.5 x 2.6 cm – brown

coordination card - distressed

Scraps of glitter card gold – cut into leaf shape



Assembling the project:

With a brown card blank in portrait position, measure & mark both top & bottom at the central point at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in the line & fold, creasing the card well, repeat with the second card. Turn one of the folded cards upside down then align & affix to the inside back of the first.

Open up the card & secure the brown embossed Cordinations card to the inner back. On both front flaps of the card, fold the top corner edge over to the side crease, forming 'lapels'. Attach the two triangular pieces of paper to these lapels, & the two rectangular pieces below in both card flaps.

Attach the two glitter leaves to the uppermost lapel (the left one) topped with the Cordinations embossed & die cut circle.

Creating the paper rose:

Roughly tear a circle from the scrap of Cordinations card. Scrunch up & then flatten again. With an old emery board or similar, scuff both sides of the paper. Roughly tear the card into a spiral. Starting from the outside, begin to roll the spiral aligning one edge as you go. Allow to rest on your workspace & then gently roll the edges of the petals. Fix the rose to the centre of the brown circle.

Attach the distressed Cordinations tag to the lower portion of the left hand card flap using double sided foam tape.
