

# Cafe Latté Card Collection

## (4) Framed Butterfly

What you will need to replicate this project:-

- 1 x A5 Card blank – cream
- 10 x 18 cm rectangle cut from the 30 cm square sheet
- 8.6 x 12 cm embossed cordinations card – cream
- 1 x 6.3 x 9.5 cm die cut frame (Cuttlebug embossing plus) - Cream
- 2 die cut glitter butterflies approx. 3.5 x 2 cm, 1 each brown & gold
- 4 small corner peel offs – gold
- Fine line border peel offs – gold
- Border peel off chain - gold

Assembling this project:-

With a cream card blank in portrait position, measure & mark both top & bottom at the central point at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in the line & fold, creasing the card well.

Scrape the lower edge of the 10 x 18 cm paper with a bone folder to break up the fibres slightly, & roll up approx. 4 cm. Using double sided tape; secure this centrally to the front of the card, with the paper roll at the base. Attach the rectangle of embossed card on top, allowing a border of the decorative paper showing all around.

Run lengths of fine line border peel offs around the edge of the embossed card & around three sides of the decorative paper & then below the paper roll.

With the embossed frame, attach corner peel offs to the four corners & the chain peel off around the aperture. Turn the frame over & fix foam adhesive pads to the back & position centrally on top of the embossed card.

Secure one die cut glittered butterfly into the aperture & use more foam tape on the reverse, down the body, of the second & align directly above the first. Tweak the wings to give the illusion of movement.
