

Cafe Latte Card Collection (1)

(1) Paper Rose

What you will need to replicate this project:-

- 1 A5 Card blank – Cream
- 1 rectangle 10 x 14 Cm cut from the 30 cm square sheet
- 1 strip 7mm x 18 Cm cut from same sheet
- Scrap of card in Cream
- 2 glitter die cut butterflies 10 x 6 Cm, 1 brown & 1 gold
- 1 small glitter daisy die cut– brown
- Chain border peel offs - gold
- Scrap of acetate large enough to cover one butterfly

Assembling this project:-



With a cream card blank in portrait position, measure & mark both top & bottom at the central point at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in the line & fold, creasing the card well. Attach the 10 x 14 cm rectangle of paper centrally, to the card front & trim with the border peel off.

Secure one of the die cut butterflies to the scrap acetate & trim around the edge. Affix the other directly to the card front at an angle, toward the lower left of the card. Fold the other butterfly down through the body & secure directly on top of the first one & then shape the wings.

Creating the paper rose:

Roughly tear a circle from the scrap of Coordinations card. Scrunch up & then flatten again. With an old emery board or similar, scuff both sides of the paper. Roughly tear the card into a spiral. Starting from the outside, begin to roll the spiral aligning one edge as you go. Allow to rest on your workspace & then gently roll the edges of the petals. Secure to the centre of the die cut daisy.

Creating the bow:

With the strip cut from the 12" square paper, fold in half & then in half again to create 4 sections. Roll the two inner sections to the central crease forming the bow. Fold back the outer sections to form the tails of the bow & secure.

Attach the bow to the top right of the card & then fix the rose & daisy combo to the centre.
