

## Chocolate Angled Easel Cupcake Project

What you will need to recreate this project:

1 x 15 cm square card blank - white

*\* 1 x 14.3 cm square decorative paper*

*\* 1 x 14.3 x 14.3 cm right angled triangle of above*

1 x 10.5 x 12 cm foiled card - gold

1 x 7.5 x 2.5 cm foiled card - gold

1 x 10 x 11.5 background card - colour to suit

1 x 10 x 3.2 cm background card - colour to suit

Greeting peel off - gold

Cupcake decoupage sets - included

*\* I have included the ones used in this project for you either to use, or to use them as templates.*



How to assemble this project:

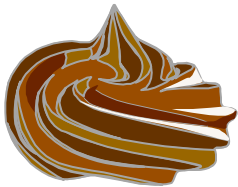
Open up the main card & score a line from the top right to bottom left on the inside front. Fold in this line & crease well. Secure the decorative paper square directly onto the inside back of the main card leaving a small border showing.

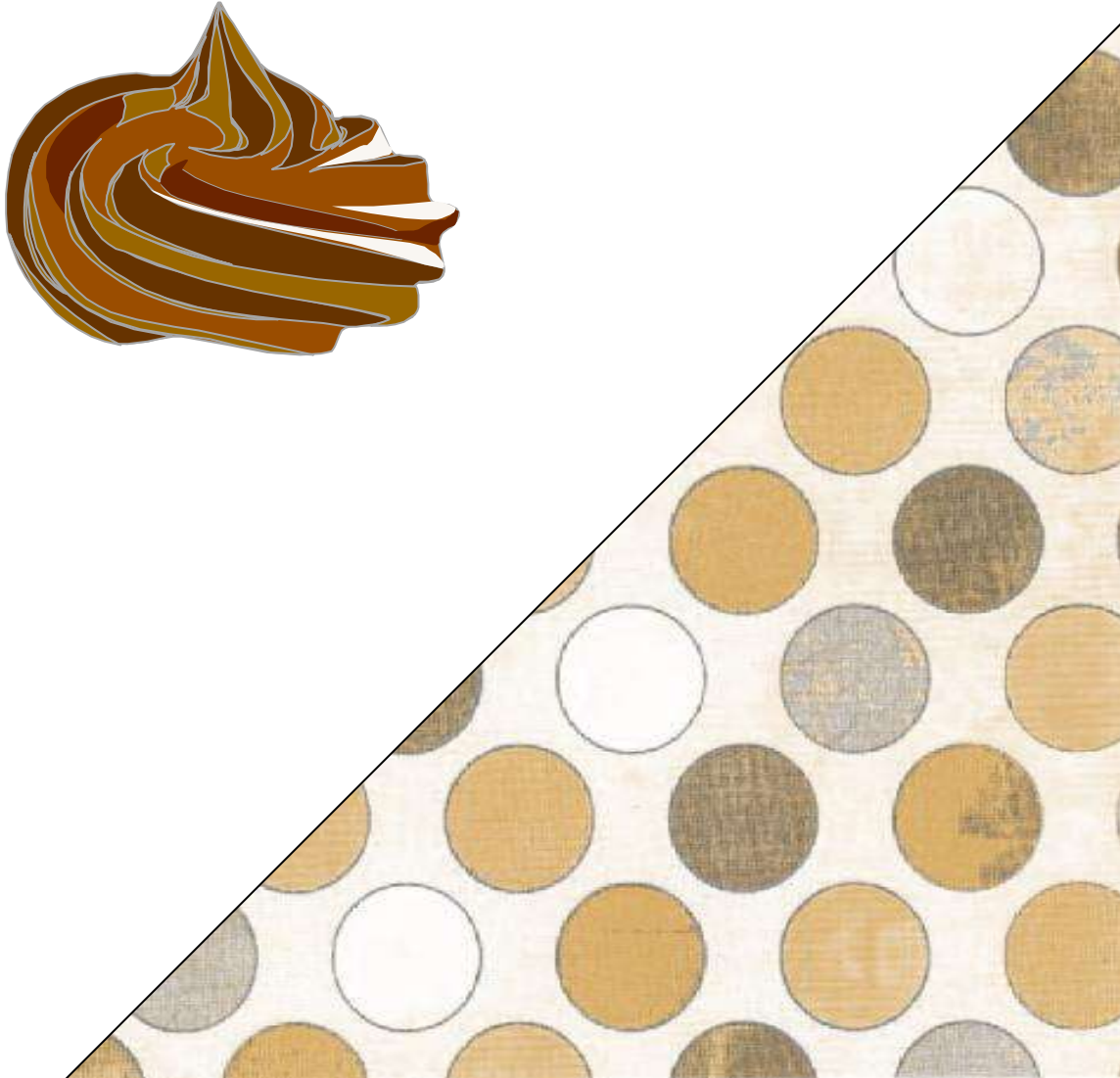
Affix the triangle of decorative paper to the front triangle of card, again allowing a border to show.

Layer the chosen card square onto the gold foiled card square using double sided adhesive foam pads, & then attach more pads in a triangle formation to the lower portion on the back. Attach to the diagonal front of the card with an approx. 1 cm border at the bottom & right of the card itself.

Cut out the two cupcake decoupage sets, & using more 3D pads, layer up each. Attach the large cupcake centrally onto the chosen card panel on the front of the card.

Layer up the smaller gold foil card onto the small panel of chosen card using the adhesive pads; attach the smaller cupcake decoupage to the right hand side & the peel off greeting to the left. Open up the card & slide the easel to the desired position & affix the greeting panel in such a way that the small cupcake decoupage is the stopper preventing the card from sliding closed.





I recommend glazing/varnishing the cake & icing portions of the cupcakes.
