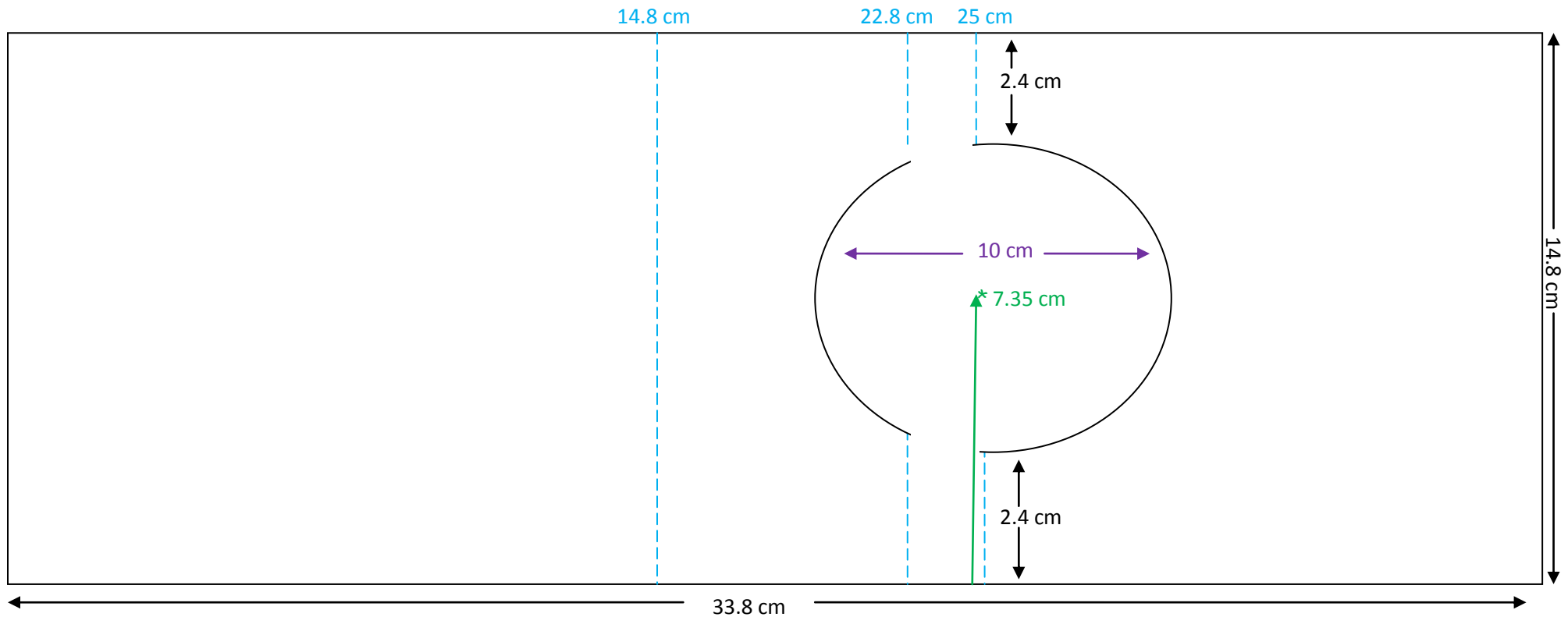


Circular Spinner Card Worksheet

You will need a sheet of A3 card for this project, but each sheet will make 2 cards



Instructions:

With an A3 sheet of card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point up both sides at approx. 29.7 cm, draw in this line & cut. Put half aside for a future project.

With the card still in landscape position, mark in the **turquoise** measurements (above) on both the top & bottom of your card. On the 25cm line measure up from the base to **7.35cm** & make a mark.

Use this as the central point for your compass. Set the compass point at ZERO on your ruler & the pencil end to 5 cm (giving a 10cm circle). Draw in the circle. Cut around the circle carefully, but leave attached the central band as shown in the diagram above.

Score the **turquoise** perforated lines only to the edge of the circle & then fold as follows:- 14.8 cm back to back; 22.8 cm front to front & 25cm back to back - leaving the circle intact. Once folded the edges of the card should align perfectly.
