

## Delicate Celebration

### What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A5 card – white
- 1 x A5 embossed foil card – silver (plus scraps)
- 1 x 15 cm square decorative vellum
- \*3 x small paper roses – red
- 2 x paper leaves – green
- Foil greeting – silver approx 3.5 cm square
- \* Photographic help file available on site



### How to assemble the project:

With the A5 card in landscape position, measure & faintly mark both top & bottom at 14.8 cm. Score in this line, fold & crease well.

Open up the card & run a border of double sided adhesive tape (DST) around the inner front. Lay the square of vellum so it aligns with all of the edges on the back of the card before peeling away the backing paper on the DST & closing the card to secure in position. Trim vellum if necessary.

From the A5 embossed foil card, measure & cut out the following two pieces: 5.6 x 13.8 cm & 10.4 x 13.8 cm. Using DST, attach the smaller piece centrally to the front panel of the card & attach the larger piece centrally to the right hand side of the inner back of the card. From the scraps cut a 4.8 cm square before cutting it diagonally through the middle. Attach to the top & bottom corners of the vellum.

Using the help file on site, create three small paper roses using red paper. If you do not have any paper leaves, use a leaf punch or cut free hand. Using tacky glue secure the three roses to the upper section of the embossed foil panel on the card front, followed by the leaves.

Finally trim the greeting & attach using double sided adhesive pads. Position below the red rose bouquet.
