

Tenderly Yours Collection: Doily & Shells

What you will need to recreate this project:

1 x A5 card - white

7.5 cm cut out circle from the 'Paper Flowers' project

9.9 x 14.1 cm rectangle from the base paper

Small 9 cm doily (foraged from wine bar or coffee shop)

3 small acrylic shell buttons - or small sea shells

Beaded ribbon flower – colour to co-ordinate with base paper.



How to assemble this project:

Using your chosen adhesive, fix the cut out circle of base paper to the centre of the doily & put aside to dry.

With your A5 card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point both top & bottom at approx. 10.5cm. Score in this line & crease firmly. With the card closed & in portrait position measure & mark a point 3.2 cm in from the open edge on the card front. Draw in this line & cut away.

Open up the card & with your chosen adhesive, mount the base paper panel centrally inside the back of the card allowing a small even border to remain visible all around.

Close up the card once more & with your same chosen adhesive, mount the doily panel centrally onto the front of the card. (Position as if the card were still intact & it will be central).

You will need some form of glue gel, particularly if you are using real sea shells, to embellish the card.

Position the ribbon flower at roughly the 10 o'clock position, on the edge of the doily & then secure the shells – real or acrylic – in a desirable position below the ribbon flower. Put aside overnight until the gel glue has firmly set.
