

Flip Chart Style Card Project

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A4 card blank - white
- 1 x A4 paper to use as insert
- 1 x 12.5 x 13.7 cm pearl card – antiqued gold
- 1 x 13 x 9 cm image
- 1 x 9.5 x 13.3 cm foiled card – colour to compliment your image
- Approx 45cm ribbon to compliment your image
- Office hole punch



How to assemble the project:

With the A4 card blank in portrait position, measure & mark along the short sides to 14.8 cm, draw in this line & cut away the excess. Turn the card to horizontal position, measure & mark the central position both top and bottom at 14.8 cm. Score in this line & fold, creasing well.

Repeat the same process with the A4 paper, but cutting it slightly smaller to use as an insert for your card.

Turn the card right way up, measure & faintly mark a point at 3.5 cm from the fold both top & bottom & score in this line.

From the pearl card, cut a strip from one end measuring 2.6 x 13.7 cm. Using double sided adhesive tape (DST) position this strip centrally on the front of the card between the fold & the scored line. (See main picture).

Slip the paper insert into the card & centre the hole punch on the card fold, punch the holes.

Cut the ribbon into two identical lengths & tie through the holes in the card, as well as the insert. Finish off with a bow. Gently separate the two ribbons to expand the bows.

Gently open up the card & softly flex the scored line. Do not fold on the line.

Layer the image onto the foil card & then the pearl card, position centrally on the lower portion of the card, below the scored line.
