

# Glitter Spangles Waterfall Project

## What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A4 card blank - cream
- 1 x A4 foiled card - gold
- 1 x A5 matt card - gold
- 1 x A5 glitter card - buttermilk
- 2 x small square brads - gold
- 1 x large eyelet - gold
- 4 x 5 cm square glitter card scraps in a variety of colours
- 2 x foiled card scraps measuring 14.5 x 6 & 12.5 x 6 cm - gold
- 4 small images to compliment above
- 1 small tassel/scrap of ribbon
- Pencil, ruler & scissors
- DST
- Eyelet setter



## How to assemble this project:

With the card in horizontal position, measure and mark the centre point of approx 14.8 cm both top and bottom, score this line using the side of the blade of a closed pair of scissors against the ruler to break down the card fibres enabling a crisp fold. Fold into this line and define the crease by dragging the tip of the ruler down the fold using pressure from your forefinger on the ruler.

Mark, measure and cut a rectangle from one corner of the A4 gold foil card to measure 12.5 x 16.5 cm, put the remainder aside for now. Mount DST on the back of the buttermilk glitter card, and centrally to the foil card panel, then apply DST to this too.

From your matt gold card, mark, measure and cut out 4 x 6 cm squares, in the centre of each mount the 5 cm squares of glitter card, attach the images centrally on top.

Using the template attached, construct the slider components.

Fold the one scored line on the back of the mechanism fully forward, foil side to foil side & crease well. BEND the three scored lines on the front of the mechanism back, plain side to plain side, gently but do not fold. Using DST attach the anchor card face up & central across the very bottom of the front part of the mechanism allowing flaps to extend. Attach DST to the folded portion and secure to the front of the mechanism so that the gold side is facing uppermost on both.

With the four glittered squares face down and in upright position, attach a strip of DST to the top of each. Position the first on the lowest score line on the front of the mechanism, with the other two above on their own score lines, the final one is positioned level with the top of the mechanism. Pierce a hole in the centre bottom on the back of the mechanism and attach an eyelet. Fit tassel or tie ribbon through the eyelet.

Lay the mechanism centrally onto the buttermilk glitter card & carefully make a hole through each of the slider tabs, going through both the glitter & foil card too. Attach a brad into each to secure. Peel away the backing paper from the back of the panel & position approx. 3 cm from the base, on the card front.

All measurements taken from base of mechanism marked by a heavy black line in diagrams. Perforated lines indicate where to score (on reverse of card).
