

Indian Summer Card Collection - Lazy Sunday Afternoon

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A6 card (10.5 x 14.8 cm) card blank - white
- 9 x 9.6 cm Core'dinations Gemstones cardstock - turquoise
- 3 x 10.5 cm Core'dinations Gemstones cardstock - turquoise
- 8.6 x 2.5 cm Core'dinations Gemstones cardstock - turquoise
- 8.2 x 8.7 cm Foiled card - silver
- Fine line border peel offs - silver
- Medium ribbon bow - blue
- Tiny peel off butterfly - silver
- 2 x small peel off butterflies - silver
- Peel off greeting - silver
- Scrap of acetate
- Central strip from the cake wrap paper used in the 'Sunlight on the Water' card



How to assemble this project:

Firstly, attach the central strip from the cake wrap down the centre of the 3 x 10.5 cm gemstones card, then highlight each edge of the paper with border peel offs. Attach the strip down the front of the main card, (& to save unnecessary measuring) left of centre - see main picture.

Then attach peel off borders around the following:

Front of main card:

9 x 9.6 cm gemstones card stock:

6.6 x 2.5 cm gemstones card stock:

Foiled card

Go back to the piece of 6.6 x 2.5 cm gemstones card stock & attach the tiny butterfly into the bottom left corner & the greeting centrally across the rest of the panel, leaving space for the ribbon bow to be added later.

Layer up the main panel; beginning with the largest piece of gemstone card stock, attach the silver foil card centrally, allowing a border to remain visible. Next attach the piece cut from the feature, 30 cm square paper.

Attach the peel off butterfly into the bottom right hand corner. Mount this panel in the upper two thirds of the main card using 3D pads.

Add the greeting panel, again using 3D pads, centrally below the main panel. Using glue gel attach the ribbon bow to the top right hand corner of the panel.

Finally, mount the second butterfly onto the scrap of acetate & trim out. Flex the wings to imitate flight & using gel glue on the body, align on top of the first.
