

Indian Summer Card Collection - Mysteries of Nature

What you will need to recreate this project:

1 x A6 card blank (14.8 x 10.5 cm) white

14.3 x 9.8 cm corrugated foil card - silver

*13.5 x 9.3 Core'dinations card - blue to co-ordinate with paper

13.5 x 6 cm from 30 cm (12") square paper

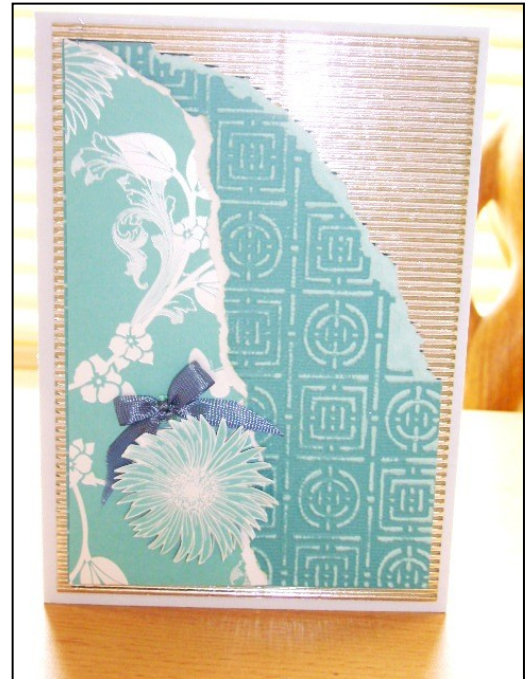
Flower - cut from above paper

Approx. 20 cm x 6-7mm ribbon - blue

*Embossing folder of your choice

*Embossing machine

* You can easily substitute any embossed card stock that will work with your project.



How to assemble this project:

This is a real easy one, simply a case of matting & layering, & a bit of tearing too!

You will need to use a gel based glue or photo glue to stick the corrugated foil card to the centre front of the main card, as PVA type glues, including Tacky glue will not bond permanently.

Run the Core'dinations through your machine & then use sand paper/emery boards or something similar to 'distress' the card & reveal the core.

With the pattern side facing you, slowly tear from a little way in on the top left down to about half way on the right hand edge. Using the same glue fix this panel onto the corrugated foil, leaving a border showing. (See main photo).

Repeat the tearing in the same manner with the paper itself; though tear all of the way down the right hand side this time. Layer this piece onto the Core'dinations piece & fix the individual cut out flower on the bottom right.

Tie a bow using the ribbon, & with the same glue as earlier, fix carefully above the individual flower.
