

Indian Summer Card Collection - Sunlight on the Water

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A6 card blank (10.5 x 14.8 cm)
- 8 x 8.5 cm panel from the 30 cm square paper
- 8.5 x 9.2 cm corrugated foil card - silver
- 21 x 1.5 cm cake wrapping paper band - silver
- 15 x 6 cm cake wrapping paper band*
- 30 cm x 7cm ribbon - soft navy colour
- 2 x medium peel off butterflies - silver
- Scraps of very thin acetate

* This length of cake wrap will be used between this card & another in the collection.



How to assemble this project:

Preparation: Tie a 4 cm bow in the centre of the ribbon. Stick both butterfly peel offs on to the acetate & trim out, bend the wings gently to imitate flight. Trim the centre panel from broad cake wrap & put aside for another card in this collection.

Using photo glue or similar, attach the paper panel to the ribbed foil panel. (Tacky/PVA glue does not make a permanent bond when used with foiled card). From the cake wrap cut earlier, use one of the edgings & decorate down the left hand side of the paper panel.

Attach the narrow cake wrap in a strip along both top & bottom of the main card. (See main picture).

Attach large 3D pads (double sided adhesive foam pads) to the back of the ribbed foil panel & position centrally on the front of your main card. Using a clear glue gel, dab a little down the body of the butterflies & attach at an angle onto the paper panel. Finally, using the same glue gel, attach the ribbon bow at the top left of the panel & put the card aside to dry.
