

## Indian Summer Card Collection - The End of Summer

### What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A6 card blank (10.5 X 14.8 cm) white
- 8 x 11 cm embossed mulberry paper - cream & gold
- 5 x 8.5 cm corrugated foil card - silver
- 4.5 x 8 cm from the 30cm square paper
- 1 die cut & embossed leaf - white
- 1 medium blue ribbon bow
- 4 small square acrylic gems - turquoise



### How to assemble this project:

Here is another pretty easy project that is just a case of matting & layering.

Use a permanent tape runner to position the mulberry paper centrally on the front of the main card. Attach an acrylic gem in each corner of the paper.

Use 3D pads, (double sided adhesive foam pads) to mount the paper from the 30 cm square sheet, centrally onto the corrugated foil card, & to attach the leaf.

Attach more pads to the back of the corrugated card & secure at an angle onto the mulberry paper.

Using gel glue, attach the ribbon bow beneath the leaf.
