

10 cm Box - unadorned

(Suitable for Maze Book Project)

What you will need to complete this project:

2 x A4 card blanks - colour to suit the project

Pencil, ruler, scissors

PVA glue/tacky glue

Paperclips or household washing pegs

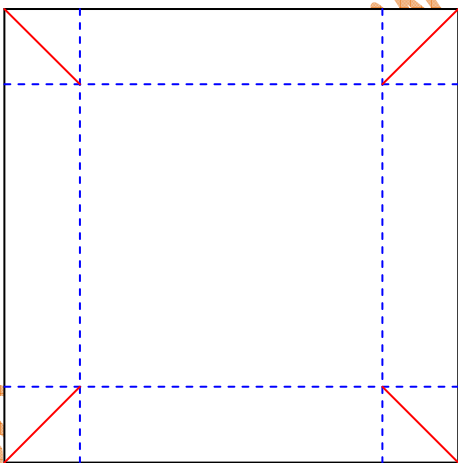


How to assemble this project:

With the A4 card in horizontal position, measure and mark both top and bottom at 21 cm, draw in the line. Repeat with the second card.

Card 1 - the lid:

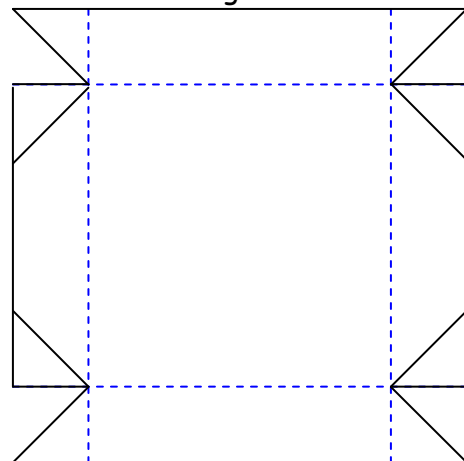
Measure and mark along each of the four sides on the following measurements: 5.5 & 15.5 cm. When all four sides are complete, 'draw' in the line with a ruler and the side of a closed pair of scissors - this is known as 'scoring'. Using the pencil and ruler, draw a diagonal line from the very corner of the card square, to where these score lines cross, repeat on all 4 corners. (See diagram below). Cut these lines in as far as the score lines only.

Repeat all steps with card 2 - the base, substituting these measurements for those used above: 5 & 15 cm.

Fold all of the scored lines forming 4 sides and 8 end flaps.



Fold four of the end flaps back to the open position and leave four still folded. Apply PVA glue to the side of the flaps facing up, thus the inside of the unfolded ones, and the outside of the folded ones. Adhere into position and clip into position until the glue is dry.
