

Paris Nights Collection Amour

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A5 card - mushroom
- 12 x 5 cm approximately - Core'dinations card - cream
- Cuttlebug embossing plus die & machine
- 3 silk flower heads approx. 6cm - 2 red & 1 orange
- Silk leaves
- Medium brad - red
- 7.4 x 10.5 cm paper from 30 cm (12 x 12") square
- [Large border punch with approx. 3 cm depth design*](#)
- 4 x 10.5 cm foiled card - gold



*Here I used a punch by EK Success

How to assemble this project:

Use the punch to create the decorative border along one short edge of the A5 card, then fold & crease the card in half. Doing the punching first ensures that the card is perfect proportioned.

Run the Core'dinations card through the die cutting machine to cut & emboss the scroll. Then, lay the shape flat on your work surface & gently rub over the surface with an emery board or similar, to distress the top layer & reveal the core. Dust the shape & the work surface thoroughly.

With your chosen adhesive secure the piece of decorative paper above the punched edge, trim if necessary at the card crease.

Using glue gel or double sided adhesive, position the die cut scroll across the front of the card to overhang the punched area. (See main image).

Layer the silk flowers onto the brad, with the red at the front & the leaves at the back. Using either glue gel or a double sided adhesive pad, position the flower at the top right of the scroll.

Open up the card & using your choice of adhesive, fix the gold foil card to the open edge on the inside back, so that it is visible through the punched area on the card front, when the card is closed.
