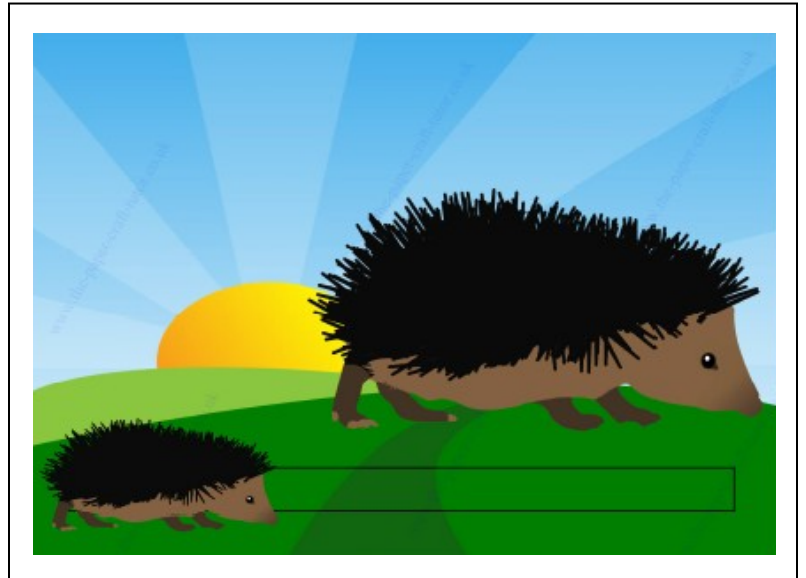


Penny Slider Hedgehog Family

Version 2

What you will need to create this project:

- 1 x A4 card blank - white
- 1 x A5 card blank - white
- Scrap of card
- Sheet of hedgehog elements
- Narrow 3D adhesive foam tape
- Medium 3D adhesive foam pads
- Emery board
- Glue - either wet or in a stick
- 2 x 1 pence pieces

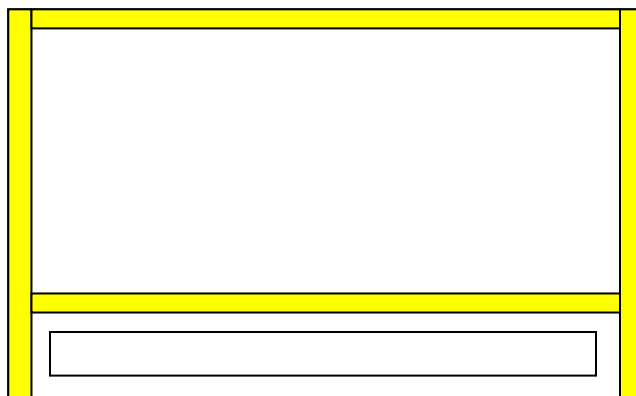


How to assemble this project:

Cut out the main picture from the bottom of the sheet; mount to the A5 card & leave to dry.
Cut the large hedgehog, & glue the small hedgehog to the scrap of card & put aside to dry.

With the A4 card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point's both top & bottom at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in the line & fold, creasing well.

Using a craft knife & cutting mat, carefully cut out the slot on the lower edge of the main picture, retaining the piece for use on the card. The best way to do this is to always use the ruler to cover the main part of the piece you are cutting from, this way should the blade slide you will not damage the main image. Use the emery board to smooth the edges of the slot.



Mount the main picture with narrow 3D tape as shown by the highlighted areas in the diagram above. Peel away the backing paper & layer a second level of tape on top.

Before peeling away the backing paper, glue the back of the cut out strip & position the main picture centrally onto the main card. Slip the cut out strip through the aperture, remove the picture & secure the strip firmly to the card. Now, peel off the backing paper & reposition the image to the card.

Whilst still on the carrier sheet, peel the backing paper from one medium 3D pad & stick another directly on top. Roughly cut around the carrier sheet to isolate the pads & then cut roughly into a smooth circle. Peel away from the carrier sheet & attach centrally to the first penny, peel away the backing paper & align the second penny directly on top, press down well to ensure adhesion.

Cut out the small hedgehog from the scrap of card.

Stick a further 3D pad to the top penny - you will probably need to trim the pad - & stick the smallest hedgehog centrally to the top. Carefully slide the penny sandwich into the runner. If it catches anywhere you either need to sand the edges of the slot a little more, or your circle of 3D pads isn't round enough.

Finally, using more 3D pads, position the larger hedgehog to the centre right on the front of the card - ensuring that it does not impede the slider.
