

"Pretty as a picture" acetate project

What you will need to recreate this project:

30 x 15 cm heavy weight acetate - clear
1 x floral decoupage image approx. 10 cm square
1 x 11.5 cm square regular card stock - cream or white
1 x 12 cm square foiled card - silver
1 x 11.5 cm square textured foiled card - mint green
Pencil, ruler & scissors
DST & silicone glue or 3D pads



How to assemble this project:

1. With the acetate in landscape position, measure & mark - with the tip of your scissor blade - the central point at 15 cm both top & bottom & score in the line. Fold the acetate as you would a normal card, using the tip of the ruler to define the crease.
2. Layer up the mint green card onto the silver foiled card using DST, then mount centrally onto the front of the acetate 'card'. Open up the 'card' and using the same DST, position the regular card square on the reverse of the front panel, centrally where it will not be visible from the front.
3. Work up the layers of decoupage using either 3D pads or silicone glue & position centrally onto the mint green textured foil card panel.
