

Raspberry & Chocolate Hot Summer Night

What you will need to create this project:

1 x A5 card blank - cream or white
1 x A5 foiled card - gold
5 x 7 cm foiled card - gold
5.5 x 7.5 cm card - black
10 x 14 cm Basic Grey: Ambrosia Slice paper
2 x 4.25 x 14 cm decorative paper
1 x 4.5 x 6.5 oriental image
35 x .5 cm satin ribbon - red
Pencil, ruler & scissors
DST or glue stick & 3D pads



How to assemble this project:

With the card blank in landscape position measure and mark the following points at both top and bottom: 5.25 & 15.75 cm and score in these lines. Fold the card to form a wardrobe door style.

From the A5 foiled card mark, measure and then cut three rectangles, two measuring 4.9 x 14.4 cm, and a third measuring 10.3 x 14.4 cm. From the decorative paper mark, measure and cut a further three rectangles, two measuring 4.4 x 14 cm, and the final one measuring 9.7 x 14 cm.

Using the glue stick or DST, layer each of the decorative paper rectangles onto the corresponding foiled card rectangles, allowing a fine gold border to showing all around.

Layer the image onto the separate piece of foiled card, and then onto the black card. Turn over the image adding 3D pads to the right hand half only.

On the interior of the card centralise the largest of the matted rectangles secure in position using DST. On the exterior of the card, attach the two panels centrally onto the 'wardrobe doors'.

Using DST, attach the ribbon across the back of the card, and then across the front left panel. Peel away the paper from the 3D pads on the image and position centrally, on top of the ribbon, between the two front panels.

Tie a bow in the ribbon at the right hand edge of the card.
