

Raspberry Chocolate

Long Hot Summer

What you will need to create this project:

- 1 x A5 card blank - cream
- 9.5 x 14 cm Basic Grey: Ambrosia Slice paper
- 3 x silk flowers - various reds
- 1 x silk leaf - green
- 1 x medium brad - red
- Paper butterfly - reds
- Craft wire - red or gold
- Pigment Ink Pad - clear or gold
- Embossing powder - gold
- Pencil, ruler, scissors & heat gun
- Glue stick or DST
- Silicone glue or 3D pads



How to assemble this project:

With the card blank in landscape position, measure and mark the central point at approx. 10.5 cm both top and bottom, then score and fold on this line.

With the ink pad almost level with the edge of your decorative paper, wipe around all sides and while the ink is still wet, sprinkle with gold embossing powder, and melt using the heat gun.

Layer up the three silk flowers with the leaf behind and secure using the brad. Adjust the petals so all three layers are visible and tighten the wings of the brad.

Using the glue stick or DST, position the decorative paper centrally onto the card front.

Bend the craft wire in half and wind both ends around a cocktail stick to form the antenna, position on the back of the butterfly with a 3D pad.

Using either 3D pads, or silicone glue position the layered silk flower top left of the card and the butterfly centrally on the right, overlapping the leaf.
