

Raspberry Chocolate Summer Romance

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A5 card blank - cream or ivory
- 6.5 x 20 cm Basic Grey: Ambrosia Slice paper
- 2 x silk flowers - deep red
- 2 x silk flowers - red
- 2 x medium brads - red or gold*
- Glitter glue - gold
- 3D leaves - gold*
- Fine border peel offs - gold
- Pencil, ruler & Scissors
- DST & 3D pads or silicone glue



*Here I used paper clay & cosmic shimmer paint to create the leaves, but you could easily use chipboard, silk or die cuts.

* You can easily re-colour brads with peel off pens or heat embossing powders

How to assemble this project:

With the base card in portrait position, measure & mark the central point both top & bottom at approx. 7.4 cm. Score in the line and fold the card, defining the crease with the tip of your ruler.

Edge the paper with the border peel offs.

Use DST and position the decorative paper centrally onto the card front. Layer up the two sets of silk flowers, with the deepest red at the back and fix with a brad.

Using either 3D pads or silicone, affix the flowers one above the other in the centre of the card, and the leaves top and bottom of the flowers, but angle the top leaf slightly.

Using care not to mark the flowers, add a touch of gold glitter glue to each brad and spread out carefully with a cocktail stick or old paint brush.
