

Raspberry Chocolate

Taj Mahal

What you will need to recreate this project:

1 x A5 card blank - red
6.5 x 20 cm Basic Grey: Ambrosia Slice paper
4.8 x 15.3 cm co-ordinating paper - red
4.8 x 15.3 cm foiled card - red
'Puzzle' punch approx 2.7 cm square
3 medium acrylic gems - red
Narrow peel off borders - gold
Pencil, ruler & scissors
DST & 3D pads



How to assemble this project:

With the card blank in portrait position measure & mark the central point at both top and bottom at approx. 7.4 cm. Score in this line and fold the card and define the crease by dragging the tip of the ruler down the crease.

With the co-ordinating paper face down and in landscape position, measure and mark the following points: 2.5, 7.75 & 13 cm. Use these marks against the central point on the front lip of your puzzle punch to position the three patterns in the paper. Push the paper into the punch as far as it will go to ensure the patterns will line up correctly.

Using DST, mat the punched paper onto the foiled card. Trim the centre of each pattern with an acrylic gem and the edge of the panel with the peel off borders.

Still using the DST, fix the decorative paper centrally onto the card front, once again trimming the edge of the paper with the peel off borders.

Affix 3D pads to the back of the punched panel and position centrally onto the card front.
