

Red Hot Passion

What you will need to create this project:

1 x A5 card blank - black
8.5 x 13 cm Mirri Board - gold embossed
7.5 x 12 cm gold mesh
6 x 10 cm corrugated card - red
2 marabou feathers - 1 red & 1 black
60 x .5cm black ribbon with gold thread
Border peel off - gold chain
4 x .5cm brads - gold square
1 x A5 paper liner
Pencil, ruler & scissors
DST (double sided adhesive tape)
3D pads (double sided adhesive foam pads)
Hole punch



How to assemble this project:

With the black card in horizontal position measure and mark the central point both top and bottom at approx. 10.5cm, 'draw' in the line using the edge of a closed pair of scissor blades and a ruler - this is known as 'scoring' and breaks down the fibres of the card making it easier to fold and crease neatly. Fold the card into the score line.

Position the two feathers on the top third of the mirri board and lay the gold mesh centrally onto the board and carefully, using the point of the scissors, poke a tiny hole through the board at the corners so that the brads will secure the mesh and feathers to the board.

Using DST, secure the mirri board centrally to the main card front.

Cut out the templates provided with this hand out, and on the reverse of the red corrugated card, transfer the designs, including the holes to be punched. Carefully cut out the designs, and using the border peel offs decorate the designs to your preference. Cut the black ribbon in half, and then cut one half in half once again. Use the longer length to thread through the bodice and tie off in a bow. Tie the remaining two lengths into small bows and using a portion of a 3d pad attach these to the undies.

With 3d pads spaced equally throughout, attach the set diagonally across the main card.

Fold the card liner in half and run a length of DST down the front fold, peel away the backing paper and carefully slide inside the card, close the card and run a finger down the spine to secure.
