

## Side Stepper Instructions

Print out the template sheet of this project sheet on copier card.

Cut along the top & bottom heavy black lines of the template.

Using a craft knife, cutting mat & metal ruler carefully cut through the red line on the template.

From an A4 card blank, mark measure & cut away a strip measuring 6.2 x 29.7 cm from one side.

Lay the template onto this card & align carefully. You may find it easier to use some clear or masking tape to fix the template in position while you work. (In order not to damage the card, stick the tape to your clothing & peel away a couple of times before using to secure the template).

Score across the perforated lines through the template & onto the card - do not extend past the ends of the lines.

Once again use your craft knife etc. to cut through the red line & through the card beneath the template.

Remove the template.

With your card right side facing & beginning with the line marked in blue on the template, fold back so that the wrong sides of the card face each other. This is called a mountain fold.

On the next line do the opposite, so right sides of the card face each other. This is called a valley fold.

Carry on alternating these two folds until you have creased all of the scored lines on the left of the card.

Fold the central line on the right of the card in a mountain fold.

This can be a bit confusing at first, so if at any point you come unstuck, use the photo on the template for guidance.

If you do not succeed the first time, don't worry - after all it is only a piece of card, throw it away & try again.

Decorate as you wish.
