

Tenderly Yours Collection: Floating Heart

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A5 Card – white
- 1 x A5 Satin foiled card - gold
- Approx 8 cm square scrap textured card – brown
- 9.8 x 13.8 cm piece of the base paper
- Scrap of base paper approx. 4.5 cm square
- Scrap of acetate approx. 1.5 x 7 cm
- Small silk bow - gold
- 4.5 cm Heart shaped punch or die (or templates included)
- Emery board or sanding block



How to assemble this project:

With the A5 white card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point both top & bottom at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in this line & crease firmly.

Mount the large piece of base paper centrally onto the co-ordinating satin foil card with your chosen adhesive, allowing a small border to be visible. Mount this panel centrally onto the front of the main card, again allowing a small border to be visible.

From the A5 gold satin card: cut a 10.1 x 14.1 cm rectangle. Use the larger heart & larger circle templates on page 2, to cut out one of each, also in satin foil.

From the scrap of base paper use the smaller heart template & cut out 1.

Finally, from the brown textured card, use the smaller circle template & cut out one. Then, on scrap paper & using an emery board or sanding block 'distress' the front of the circle. Thoroughly clean down your card & work area before progressing.

Fix one end of the strip of scrap acetate to the back of the base paper heart & then mount to the gold satin card, thus hiding the workings. Stick the other end of the acetate to the back of the distressed circle before mounting it to the gold satin one - making sure that all are facing forward when you are done.

Attach 3D pads (or glue gel) to the reverse of the matted gold satin circle & then mount centrally onto the front of your main card.

Finally, still using glue gel (or a slither from a 3D adhesive pad), attach the gold bow onto the 'floating' heart, in the position shown in the main photo. Put aside overnight to allow the glue gel to set properly.
