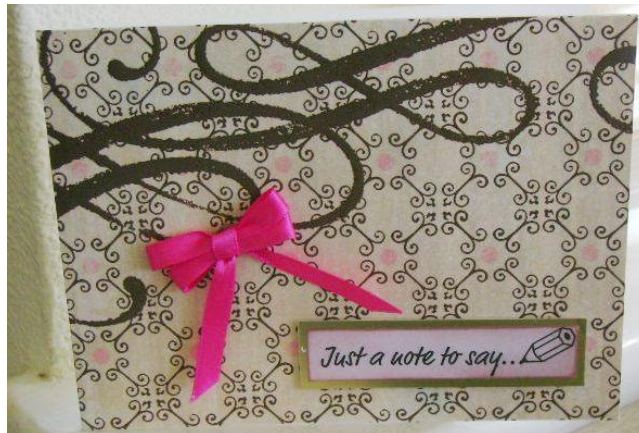


Tenderly Yours Collection: Pink Bow

What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A4 Card – white
- 7.2 x 1.5 printed greeting on white paper
- 1.9 x 7.6 cm scrap of foiled card – gold
- Length of pink ribbon tied in a double bow



How to assemble this project:

With the A4 card in landscape position, measure & mark a point up both short sides at approx. 11cm. draw in this line & cut. Put aside the smaller half for use in some later project.

With the card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point on both top & bottom at approx. 14.8 cm. Score in this line & fold the card neatly.

Place the paper greeting on a piece of scrap paper & with a brown ink pad & some form of makeup sponge/inking tool, carefully ink the edges. To do this, dab the sponge into the ink & then blot onto the scrap paper to ensure it isn't excessively loaded with ink. Then with small circular motions, beginning on the scrap paper, carefully tint the edges of the paper ensuring you do not obscure the greeting. Put aside to dry.

Using your choice of adhesive, cover the front of the card entirely & then position on the back of the base paper, over one of the swirled corners. Ensure the swirl will be at the top left of the card, & trim out. This is the easiest way to ensure you have full coverage of paper on the card.

Put the card aside & mount the inked greeting centrally onto the gold foil card scrap using your chosen adhesive. Then mount the panel with 3D foam pads (or use silicon glue gel)

Position the panel in the bottom right hand corner on the front of the card.

Finally with the same glue gel, or another piece of 3D adhesive pad, ensuring it will not be visible, position the double bow at an angle on the lower flourishes.
