

Tenderly Yours Collection: Tag & Button

What you will need to recreate this project:

1 x A5 Card – white

1 x A6 Core'dinations Card stock – brown

Scrap of above approx. 8 x 5.5 cm

Scrap of matching card – white – approx 7 x 4.7 cm

Straight line border peel offs – gold

Key Chain

Button & cotton

Scalloped Tag punch/die*

*Although this program does not have scalloped tags, I have created three layers of bullet nosed ones should you wish to use them. They are on page 2 of these project sheets.



How to assemble this project:

With the card in portrait position, measure & mark the central point up both sides at approx. 10.5 cm. Score in this line & fold the card neatly.

From a corner of the base paper, where a flourish still remains, turn over the paper & measure out the following right angled triangle, so that the flourish will travel up its length. The base will measure 9.3 cm & the height will measure 18.8 cm.

From the Core'dinations Cardstock, cut a similar triangle of 10.1 x 14.4, but allow extra to give you room to tear down the angle. Place the paper triangle on top of the Core'dinations one & rip down the angle & toward you - slowly, using your fingers to control the tear. Allow the Core'dinations card to be visible behind the base paper.

Use your chosen adhesive to bond the two together. From the scrap, tear off a tiny corner approx. 2.2 x 2.5 cm. Use a scrap of the base paper to cut a smaller triangle & mount this to the torn Core'dinations corner.

Secure both triangle layers onto the main card, as seen in the photograph & then join them up with the straight line gold peel offs.

Attach some co-ordinating cotton through the button & tie off. Secure this to the bottom right hand corner of the triangle of base paper, using either glue gel or a snippet of 3D adhesive pad.

If you do have a nested die, cut out three tags from the Core'dinations, base paper & white card. If you have a punch, use it once & then draw around it increasing the size by a couple of millimetres, &

repeat until you have three layers. Otherwise use the templates that I have included in the same order as mentioned above.

Punch a hole through all three layers & attach the key chain. Mount at an angle onto the main card either with 3D adhesive pads or glue gel. Put aside to dry.
