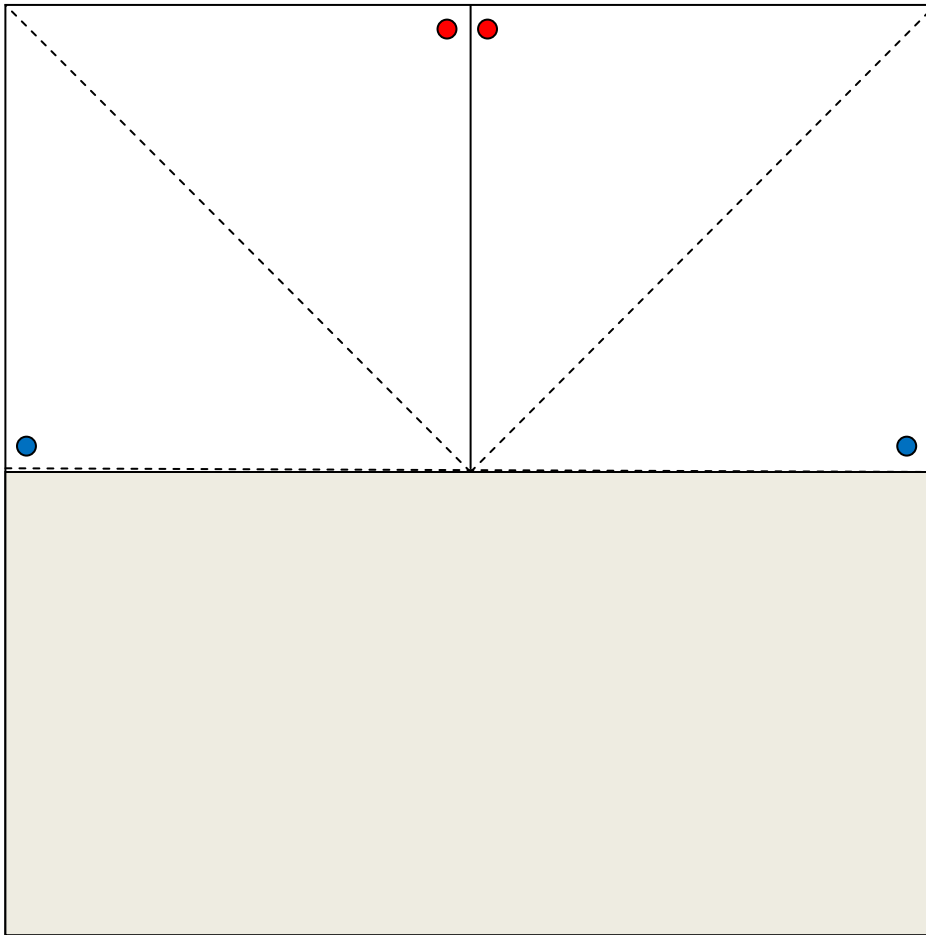


# Twisted Easel Card Worksheet

I saw this new card fold created by Nancy Watt on C+C



Start with a piece of card measuring 21 cm square.

Score a line across the halfway point of 10.5 cm.

Measure the halfway point across the opposite way & cut up to the central fold. Open up the card & fold the two square panels you have just created from the top centre (marked in the diagram with a red dot) down to the central fold (marked with a blue dot).

Cut out a piece of decorative card/paper using the rectangular template below, then fold the template in half & cut two pieces of decorative card.

Adhere the rectangle to the shadowed section in the diagram. Close up the card & add adhesive to the two triangular sections marked with the red dot on the reverse & secure the square panels to these.

Decorate as a normal easel card.
