

## Wings Theatre Mask Project

### What you will need to recreate this project:

- 1 x A4 card blank - red
- Scrap of co-ordinating paper approx. 10.5 x 14 cm
- Fine line border peel offs
- 1.5 x 10.5 cm scrap embossed foil paper - gold
- 2 x small decorative feathers
- 8.5 x 15.5 cm florists mesh - gold
- 2 medium hearts - gold foil (or punch out)
- Mask template - included
- Decorative edged scissors
- Stamps & heat embossing equipment



### How to assemble this project:

With the A4 card in portrait position, measure & mark the central point both top & bottom at approx 10.5 cm, draw in this line & cut the card. Put one half aside for a future project. With the remaining card in landscape position, measure & mark the central point both top & bottom at approx. 14.8 cm. Score in this line & fold to form a landscape A6 card.

Trim across one long edge of the embossed gold paper using the decorative edged scissors. Using double sided adhesive tape (DST), secure the strip along the base of the card & trim if required.

Cut out the mask template on page 2 & use to create the mask from your chosen scrap paper. Decorate the mask to your liking, using your chosen stamps & embossing powders; carefully shape using your fingers, to give it dimension.

Lay down all of the embellishments as shown in the main picture above & then apply glue gel to the back of only the mask, & secure to the card - adjust the feathers so that they are held in place by the gel on the mask.

Finally, attach the two gold hearts into a desirable position on the front of your card & put aside to dry.
